PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Similar to 2018, 2019 continued to be a building year for the Association, where we tried a few new and different things.

Craig assisted from the very beginning of the financial year by locking in the Kirribilli club for our end of season presentation night. This was a great success and we enjoyed a great turnout of over 80 guests!

A refresh of the website with easy way to pay membership was key to a good membership year. In previous years, we had collected membership payments and event registrations through an external website. Now we are able to take and update memberships, event registrations and any other fees etc in the one place, and link from Facebook events directly to the website.

We ran our first ever paid Facebook campaign to increase event awareness and reach a broader audience for our end of season function and we had a good diverse attendance. We are very quickly moving away from trying to raise awareness via traditional posters and handouts at training, as we have been provided with feedback that quite a large portion of the group find it difficult to attend trainings. By promoting on social media, we can reach people on their phones and computers at a minimal cost.

The committee invested in additional insurance for umpires, to cover loss of income in the case of injury at training or a game. Whilst we believed this would be a key incentive to become a member, the numbers proved otherwise and we won't likely pursue this in 2020.

A majority of events organised and run by the committee included a pre-season launch, a season launch (in co-operation with AFL Sydney), Heritage Night, President's Night (the first in a few years) and of course the event of season event.

Concerns raised include:

- Running events that include the group in a difficult city for transport
- Relevance of an Association for younger umpires
- Having a strong 2020 committee, interest has been limited at time of writing this report

On a sad note, we acknowledged the passing of Steve Chisholm (2nd from left below) earlier in the year. Alex (Steve's son) and Kate (partner) attended our end of season event and Andrew Scovell celebrated his time with Steve with a well worded speech. Alex is listed as a current AFL umpire and Steve was extremely proud of this achievement.
