## TREASURER'S REPORT

2012 has been another year of significant change within all areas of umpiring. The impact of this change has been far reaching and has impacted everyone involved with umpiring. NEAFL has changed the structure of our competitions and the pathway for our elite umpires, the entry of GWS into the AFL has created opportunities for umpires to progress and the generational change of the umpires group has continued thanks to the Academy system which has proved successful in transitioning junior umpires into our ranks.

With these changes come great opportunities for our members at all levels, but significant challenges as an organisation as we continue in our efforts to provide services that are relevant and important to members, as well as keeping pace in a rapidly changing environment. The committee has concentrated on providing this service and presenting a visible front as an Association to increase our exposure and understanding amongst members.

Membership packs in 2012 continued to promote the Association through our branding on the warm up shirts and other merchandise. Despite our previous bulk order of shirts and singlets, an additional order was required to top up our remaining stock. Again, significant stock remains and we will be able to sell this stock in the coming seasons. We appreciate how well this range has been received by members.

Another significant expense this year was our new fridge. This was necessary due to our old fridge breaking down over the off season. Starting the new season without a fridge created its own significant challenges but having a new one has made providing member services at North Sydney Oval significantly easier. The fridge was funded by money received from our chocolate fundraising early in the season. Thanks to all members, their friends and families for supporting the Association in this fundraiser; especially to Emma Polette who sold the most boxes by far.

A record number of umpires officiated in the group in 2012. As umpires achieve 6 games, the Association receives a grant of \$30 from the AFL to go towards providing member services to them. This is factored into the membership price, with the lowest package "base membership" now available at no cost to umpires. In 2012 144 umpires achieved this which has led to the grant. This is compared to 114 in 2011. The challenge for us as a committee is now to review why not all these 144 umpires signed up for membership and to redouble our efforts to engage all umpires with the Association and provide relevant services.

I have thoroughly enjoyed my time as treasurer of the Association. Being involved on the committee and executive of the Association has given me a whole new perspective on umpiring and increased my enjoyment of being in the group. Thanks to my fellow committee members who have put in so much effort this year. Also thanks to the members who, at many times during the year, showed their support of the committee in meetings, through attending our social events, by fundraising, offering or simply words of support.

## ADVOCACY REPORT

2012 presented unique challenges in terms of negotiation of pay and conditions with the AFL. Significant changes in terms of the structure of competitions that our members umpire in have led to us negotiating two separate agreements – a massive undertaking by a small number of dedicated and passionate committee members especially when presented with an organisation as professional and business savvy as the AFL.

The challenges of the NEAFL agreement are present in the fact that the Eastern Conference competition utilises our members, as well as the members of the AFL Canberra Umpires Association. Further to this, the NEAFL Northern and Eastern conferences were to be placed on an identical contract and procedures manual which required significant consultation amongst the umpires groups of Queensland, NT, NSW and ACT. Sub Committee of Michael Peck, Sean Richardson and I, along with representatives from ACT and Qld met with the AFL over the pre-season and managed to achieve significant gains for Eastern Conference umpires when compared to the 2011 season. NEAFL is a constantly evolving competition and I believe that we have established a solid base to work from in future seasons.

With NEAFL becoming the new elite pathway for umpires and with the allocation of resources away from the Sydney AFL competition, the negotiation of the AFL Sydney CBA provided its own hurdles. We were faced with a concerted effort from the AFL to reduce the match payments to umpires across the AFL Sydney competition. I am pleased to say that after much intense negotiation we were able to prevent this from happening, with the existing agreement renewed for the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

Currently, we are in the process of working on the NEAFL agreement for 2013 whilst negotiations on the Sydney CBA will commence early in the season.

Personally I would like to thank Sean Richardson for all his support and advice during the negotiation of these agreements; Michael Peck for leading the way with the NEAFL group and commencing their negotiations; Jeff Milne for introducing me to this facet of the association and establishing the base from which I conducted the negotiations of the Sydney CBA and also to the members, whose support I deeply appreciated throughout the process. AFL and umpiring in NSW is currently undergoing some of its most significant changes in recent times and we are not immune from the impacts of those changes. I can not overstate the importance of all umpires sticking together and remaining united as we negotiate with the league over the next 12 months to maintain and improve the conditions that we umpire under.
