Thanks also to the many members who, whilst not on the committee, were willing to offer their assistance and advice, through feedback, ideas, helping with social events or utilising their contacts to assist us with gear, venues and partner offers. To the staff at the AFL NSW/ACT, in both the umpiring and football operations departments, who have been willing to open the doors and engage with us. Finally, thanks to all our members who have contributed to the Association this year, but taking out membership, attending events and engaging with us you contribute to us once again thriving. I look forward to working with all of you again in 2014.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

2013 has been a stabilising year for the *NSWAFUA* as the separation between the AFL Sydney and NEAFL competitions has crystallised and the issues arising from providing services to umpires in each competition have been ironed out. The Association has had the pleasure of liaising with the new leadership at AFL Sydney and has made significant inroads into building a better relationship with the governing body of our great game in NSW/ACT. Through the significant work of Will Macarthur, Robert Taylor and Sean Richardson, umpires officiating in the NEAFL have standard individual contracts that reflect the professional nature of their role far better than when umpires previously umpiring in the AFL Sydney Premier Division received when Sydney Hills Eagles and Sydney University first joined the competition, whilst umpires in AFL Sydney have not seen any reduction in the conditions or remuneration provided to them despite calls from key stakeholders to do so in light of the changed structure of the competition.

The transition of these umpires over the last few years has seen a major demographic change in the AFL Sydney competition, with larger numbers of younger umpires officiating in matches on a week-to-week basis. In the 2013 season no less than 33 umpires made their debut in Premier Division, with another 7 making their respective debuts in NEAFL. Not to be outshone, more senior umpires in the group reached significant milestones, with Les Gonye umpiring in his 400th, Peter Nilson and Steven Wallbank in their 550th and Frank Kalayzich in his 600th match. It is through the collective knowledge of umpires such as these that the group moves forward in experience. Senior umpires have played a significant role in mentoring the younger umpires of the group, and as a result, we have and will continue to build depth through the development of these umpires.

Younger umpires have been a group that the *NSWAFUA* has identified, with the NSW/ACT Umpiring Department, as integral to the growth and development of the AFL Sydney and NEAFL umpiring panels, and as such, saw the Association meet groups across Sydney. We had the pleasure of attending training sessions with senior umpires from AFL Sydney and NEAFL (including former and current scholarship holders), working through discipline-specific drills and holding discussion sessions. The purpose of these visits was not only to build young umpire skills, but to provide the future of umpiring with a few 'familiar faces' so that their decisions to attend senior training at North Sydney Oval or Blacktown International Sportspark a little easier.

And at the end of the day, it is the culture and environment of our umpiring group that brings people back and new people in. As members of the *NSWAFUA* we aim to create a positive environment where all umpires feel valued. Together we make the Association what it is, so I challenge all members to make their mark by contributing in any way they can for the greater good of our group.

I would like to personally thank each of the committee members and office bearers for the mountain of work that they have done over the course of the year. A large amount of work that they do goes unnoticed but is most definitely appreciated, as is the work of the large number of additional contributors who assist the *NSWAFUA* in so many ways that the list would be longer than this report.

2013 will go down as the year the Association operated largely from the Coogee "office". Congratulations on another great season and all the best for 2014.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Increased Membership and an increase in the number of running umpires in Sydney AFL this year has seen the NSWAFUA retain a surplus this year due to increased contributions from Membership and the AFL Sydney. On top of this, completely self funded training equipment without the need to purchase additional stock has seen our overall costs compared to membership receipts drop.

Membership packs for Sydney AFL remained popular and allowed us to exhaust our remaining stock of training shirts. The packs did not require any stock to be ordered this year which allowed us to recoup some of the initial outlay from previous seasons. Furthermore, we did not have any significant capital expenses this season, unlike previous years when funds had been used to purchase a fridge and pie warmer.

Accepting NEAFL members from Canberra added some membership income this year. Canberra members are still entitled to some functions from the NSWAFUA which will be provided in due course. Further, there is a contribution to the AFL Canberra Association which is currently being retained at the relevant members' request. Taking Canberra based NEAFL members has also contributed to some travel costs associated with presenting to their group by members of the executive.

The additional income from new member bases as well as reduced expenditure this year has seen the NSWAFUA record a profit for the season.
