The highlights of the night were definitely the Q&A where life member Les Goyne stole the show and Mark Rendell inducting Frank Kalazyich into the NSWAFUA Hall of Fame of which there is no higher honour in NSW umpiring.

It is with great sadness that I acknowledge the passing of former NSWAFUA president Jeff Milne. During my eight years involved in the association I was fortunate to work with Jeff in a number of capacities and his passion and commitment to umpiring and the association was second to none. He was instrumental in the establishment of the NSWAFUA scholarship program and his impact on the association was profound. I can honestly say I am a better man for having known Jeff.

Finally I would like to take this opportunity to thank the rest of the committee for all their hard work. Liam Rowe as Vice President, Angus McKenzie-Wills as Secretary and Gordon MacArthur as Treasure. It has been their hard work and dedication that has keep the association running. I would also like to thank Frank Kalayzich for all his work with the statistics. I wrote in my 2015 report that “you don't know what you've got till its gone”. Two years ago we almost lost the NSWAFUA and I am so grateful we didn't. I am very proud to have served as the President of the NSWAFUA for the last two years and I wish the future committee all the best as they continue to build their own legacy both now and into the future.
