PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The thing about associations is you do not realise how important they are until they are no longer there. In 2015, the NSWAFUA was in a position where our extinction was a distinct possibility. Up until June, the association did not have a functioning committee or an executive. With this in mind, I am extremely proud of how the 2015 season finished.

To me, the purpose of an association is to support its members and protect their rights. This year as a committee, I feel we achieved a number of things that connect to this purpose. When it comes to protecting members' rights, this was achieved through representing our members when the AFL Sydney competition flagged the idea of having a Premier Division game each week as a two field umpire game. As a committee, we presented a strong and united front as we fought for our members' best interests. The fact that we were strong in defending our members conditions and rights and that the AFL Sydney Premier Division remained a three field umpire competition is something I am very proud of and to me proved why umpiring needs a strong and stable association.

In terms of supporting our members, we as a committee set ourselves the goal of doing a small number of things well, to give us a base to build off for season 2016. The first area we focused on was member engagement. While we still have a way to go, I feel we started the process of achieving this through holding two member functions throughout the year. The first of these was to recognise an outstanding milestone achieved by one of our members, Frank Kalayzich in umpiring 500 Premier Division games. The second was only streamlining end of season function and therefore combining Presentation and Presidents night together. I feel this was a success as it helped bring together the vast aspects of our group by recognising umpires in both AFL Sydney and NEAFL competitions on one night with both groups in attendance.

The second thing that we as a committee can be proud when it comes to supporting our members is the success of the NSWAFUA Scholarship Program. From speaking to the recipients, David Newell (Field), Michael Baker (Boundary) and Oliver Beecroft (Goal), I know found this a once in a lifetime money can't buy experience. As of 2016, the scholarship will have to be funded entirely by the NSWAFUA, so over the off season we will be investigating ways to make this financially viable for the future. In order to do that the support of our members is vital.

Heading into 2016, the NSWAFUA still faces a number of challenges. To me the biggest of these are negotiating a new CBA for the AFL Sydney group and attempting to negotiate a CBA for the NEAFL group. We also have the continued challenge of representing umpires who train at a number of venues, over a number of competitions. The current NSWAFUA executive is committed to providing some stability during this time but the reality is that for the NSWAFUA to be strong the committee needs to be an accurate reflection of its membership. As it currently stands, with an executive made up of 2 AFL umpires and 2 NEAFL umpires, I feel we are still a way off achieving this. I am therefore challenging you as members to think about how you can become actively involved in the committee of the NSWAFUA in 2016 and think about a way that you can contribute to the wider umpiring group.

Finally, I have to thank the following people for becoming part of the executive. Liam Rowe as Vice President, Angus McKenzie-Wills as Secretary and Gordon MacArthur as Treasurer. I could not have done my job without the time and effort you all put in. I would also like to thank Lachlan McDonald and Glenn Callaghan for being ordinary committee members and Frank Kalayzich for compiling the statistics. I have thoroughly enjoyed my first season as president and I look forward to representing the interests of our members into the future.

WM acknowledged that the traditional role of the association now needs some revising. WM assured those present that the new committee will have the full support of the current committee to move the new committee forward.
