



PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Mission Statement developed by your Board in 1994 was "to promote an environment which encourages umpire excellence, promotion opportunities, social harmony and fellowship".

To these ends, the season was a resounding success.

Membership remained 78 umpires, while 106 individual umpires officiated in 1509 games. Despite the loss of several established first grade umpires from the 1993 panel through transfer or retirement, this was matched by the promotion, recruitment and appointment of 21 debutants as first class professionals. Thirteen members represented your Association with distinction in 7 major intra- and interstate fixtures. There were major advances in the AFL and VSFL competitions.

Throughout the year, 14 social events were organised and were well attended. These activities are wide ranging and attempt to appeal to all members and their families/friends.

The monthly newsletter continues to be a major source of interest and speculation. This year there were 16 writers providing articles for publication. Monthly meetings continue to be very well attended.

Unfortunately some members needed reminders about our agreed dress code and the importance of punctuality. Nonetheless, the greater majority of our Association members continue to provide the highest forms of professionalism; both on and off the field.

Umpire observation and performance appraisal is of continuing concern, however, it is expected that in 1995 greater manpower in these areas will accelerate umpire skills and performance.

Congratulations to the NSWAFL for a spectacularly successful season. Our members are indebted to the NSW Director of Umpires, Keith Ogston and Terry Godfrey who provided significant input into a range of umpire assessments, development and promotion schemes. Peter Hampshire, Ken Ray and David Stuckey provided speacialist coaching for all umpires. Peter Hampshire co-ordinated all umpire appointments. We owe a big thank you to Bill Yeomans for his invaluable assistance and good humour.

AUDITORS REPORT

Scope.

We have audited the financial statements, being the Statement by Directors, Profit and Loss Account, Balance Sheet, Statement of Cash Flows and notes to and forming part of the financial statements of New South Wales Australian Football Umpires Association Limited for the year ended 31 December, 1994. The Company's Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain.
