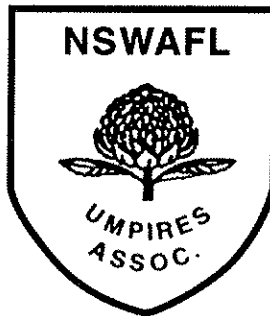

AUDITORS REPORT

Scope
