

NOTE 1: STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

AUDITORS REPORT

Scope

The Company's Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the financial statements and the information they contain. Our audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether, in all material aspects, the financial statements are presented fairly in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards and Statutory requirements so as to present a view of the Company and of the economic entity which is consistent with our understanding of their financial position and the results of their operation and cash flows.
