PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen

Over the past two seasons, successive inquiries reviewing umpiring (Fallet, Carter and Sanders) in NSW have provided a foundation for professional progress, but these strategic plans have fallen on deaf ears.

The proposed Collective Agreement, formulated between the AFLUA and your Association was tabled to the AFL NSW/ACT Commission in March 2002. It was deliberately stalled and despite continuous efforts by your Association Directors, negotiations dragged on for a full twelve months with a stench of disorganisation prevailing, before it was finally signed off in March 2003.

The departure of the Football Manager from the AFL(NSW/ACT) in June left a gigantic void in the support and administration of football in Sydney. His absence has created an impasse in the normalcy of effective business.

The adoption of electronic banking payments has had the indirect effect of reducing attendance at meetings and social functions. If financial members promote apathy and that is their collective attitude; so be it.

I wish to congratulate all members who achieved their personal and professional goals. Naturally, this includes all finals and grand finals umpires, members who represented their Association at intrastate and national carnivals and the Federal Districts Football League exchange.

Once again, your elected Board of Directors has maintained their professional integrity and continued to promote the ideals of your Association achieving significant outcomes. I am personally in their debt for their marvellous support and encouragement. In doing so, it would be remiss not to note the extraordinary efforts of the following people; Nick Angelos, Brendon Arnol, Richard Cox, Craig Davis, Grant Godfrey, Peter Hampshire, Michael Heinrichs, Peter Hiscock, David Howlett, John Livy, Joe Matchett, Kevin Meade, Garry Middlemiss, Shane McSpeerin, James McSweeney, Tim Pow, Ken Ray, Greg Rohan, Darius Samojlowcz, Mark Spooner, Andrew Smith, Bob Tait, Serge Villagra, Steve Wallbank, David Yole and Greg Young. Thank you.

After twenty seven years of umpiring football in NSW, this is my final report. Thank you for your indulgences, support and friendship. The pathway for your successes is in your hands.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 2002 season started badly for the Association when the marvelous sponsorship that the group had been successful in negotiating with Westfield Limited and had been taken over by the AFL NSW/ACT Commission, was not continued. This meant that umpires were forced into the situation of purchasing their uniforms instead of them being provided for and the massage support at training of Ipu and her staff was lost. Many thanks to Mark Ryan of Westfield for the financial backing that was forthcoming from his company. In retrospect the Association needed to continue to deal with Westfield Limited directly rather than have the AFL become involved. With the Association being involved directly with the sponsorship, it ensured that the monies went solely to umpiring. It would appear that subsequently this was not always the case.

The Board of Directors at the beginning of 2002 was determined to move forward and improve the facilities and support for members. The Association sought the assistance of David Howlett and Robert Anderson from the AFL Umpires Association. The AFLUA recommended that the NSWAFUA seek to have a formal Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) signed with the AFL NSW/ACT Commission, putting in place all conditions of employment for members.

From the original meeting with the AFLUA, a draft CBA was put together and presented to the AFL in March 2002 by Mark Rendell, Grant Godfrey and myself with the support of David Howlett and Robert Anderson. Whilst the AFL were in agreement in principle with the various clauses of the CBA, getting the CBA signed off proved to be a monumental exercise. The AFL stalled negotiating on the document, blaming the lack of a Football Operations Manager after the departure of Peter Hiscock mid season. Peter's replacement was not in place until November and from then a number of meetings were held. Originally the AFL was reluctant to agree to pay increases, providing uniforms and support staff at training and these three points were the hardest to come to agreement on.

The Association had two general meetings of members and in each instance the group was adamant that the three points mentioned were non negotiable. Finally after expressing to the AFL the mood of the members, agreement was reached in March 2003. The main points of the CBA are –

- Three year term covering 2003, 2004 and 2005 seasons
- Increases in umpire match payments over 2002 figures at 5% for 2003, 5% for 2004 and 5% for 2005.
- Tribunal Allowance of \$10 to a member who is required to attend any hearing of the tribunal.
- The AFL will provide one free uniform set to members each season.
- The AFL will provide the cost for two trainers at up to \$6,000 to attend organized training.

The members of the Association owe Grant Godfrey a huge debt for the enormous amount of time and effort he put in to negotiating the CBA. There is no doubt that



without Grant's tireless hard work, members would not have seen the successful conclusion to these negotiations. Thank you also to Simon Lawton from the AFL who took on the difficult role of putting the CBA to bed.

I implore umpires to ensure they join the Association in 2003 to take advantage of the conditions negotiated. It needs to be pointed out that the provision of one free uniform and support staff at training will only be provided to Association members. If umpires are prepared to accept match payment increases negotiated by the Association, they must be prepared to join the Association for the good of umpiring in Sydney.

My report for season 2002 must highlight the magnificent contribution retiring President Mark Rendell has made to umpiring and the Association in Sydney both on and off the field. Putting figures down in black and white, they make stunning reading.

- Mark has umpired for a total of 27 years in Sydney.
- 416 First Grade Sydney Australian Football games for a total of 604 games from 1975 to 2002.
- 7 First Grade Grand Finals as a Field Umpire.
- 7 years as President of the NSWAFUA.
- 8 years as Treasurer of the NSWAFUA.

Mark has always been the first person to put up his hand to assist umpiring in general and the Association in particular. His selfless attitude is something to marvel at and puts to shame umpires who have been involved in the sport for a number of seasons yet refuse to become involved in the administration of umpiring. They are always the first to complain yet are not prepared to help out.

A very special thank you to Mark for all his efforts over the years. He will be badly missed by the group and will be difficult to replace. Mark, enjoy your retirement and I hope your body recovers from the rigors you have put it through. No doubt the Association will still see your face around the traps, continuing to support umpiring.

Finally, as the new season is just around the corner, I encourage all members to continue to support the Association in its endeavours. The Association needs your assistance to continue in its role of developing umpiring in Sydney. Australian Football is the best game in the world. Lets make sure that umpires in Sydney are part of an explosion of the code.

TREASURER'S REPORT 2002

The financial year of 2002 was one of consolidation and rebuilding. With the recent loss of our major sponsor Westfields, a huge hole was left in the finances of the Association. The financial luxury the Association operated in over previous years, due to a major sponsor and a strong financial membership base, was not apparent in 2002. The Board needed to consolidate these two huge losses and begin the process of financial rebuilding while concurrently maintaining its yearly expenditure.

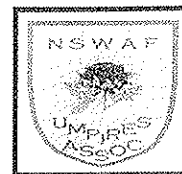
The Associations definitively greatest expense was the purchase of the new style uniforms. This purchase was to supply the demand of umpires in our metropolitan league and association, and the country leagues of New South Wales. As was expected, this placed a huge burden upon the Associations previously accrued finances and its current members. With this in mind, it must be recognized that at the close of 2002 trading, the Association held stock to the value of almost \$10,000 which is potential sales for the 2003 season.

A smaller financial membership base (8% less than 2001) placed a burden on the funding of major Association events including Presidents Night and Grand Final Night. With the increased cost of holding such esteemed functions the Members will recognize that these functions ran at a loss.

The Association members retain profits greater than those experienced in the previous year. This is a true reflection of the current finances but should not be a guide to the year ahead. The Association is in desperate need of a major sponsor. All members, being employees of the NSW AFL, should stand firm in their demands of the AFL in an attempt to secure some financial stability. Assistance needs to come in the way of uniform supplies, certified trainers and major sponsorship.

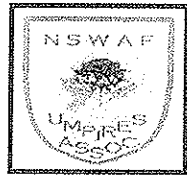

There being no further business the meeting closed at 8.10pm.

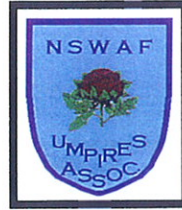

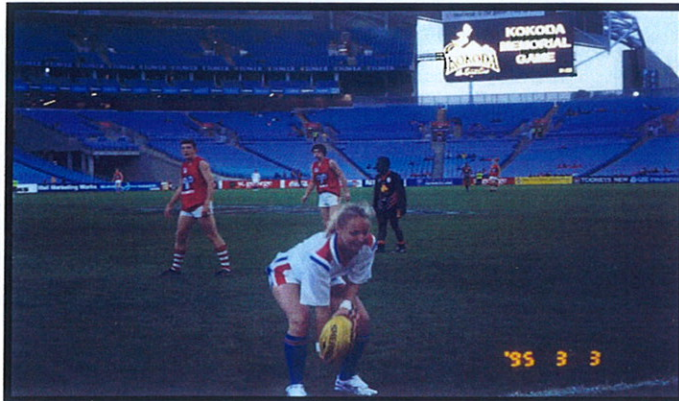

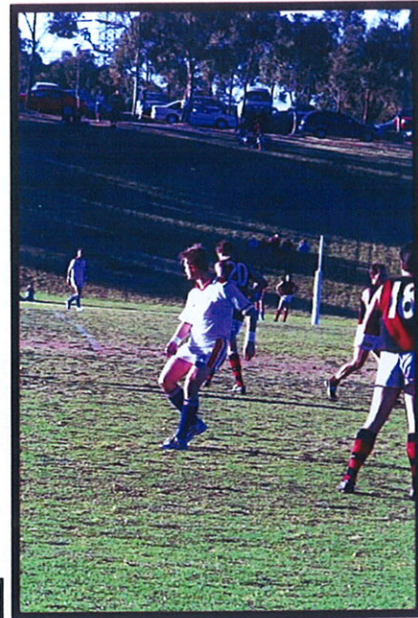
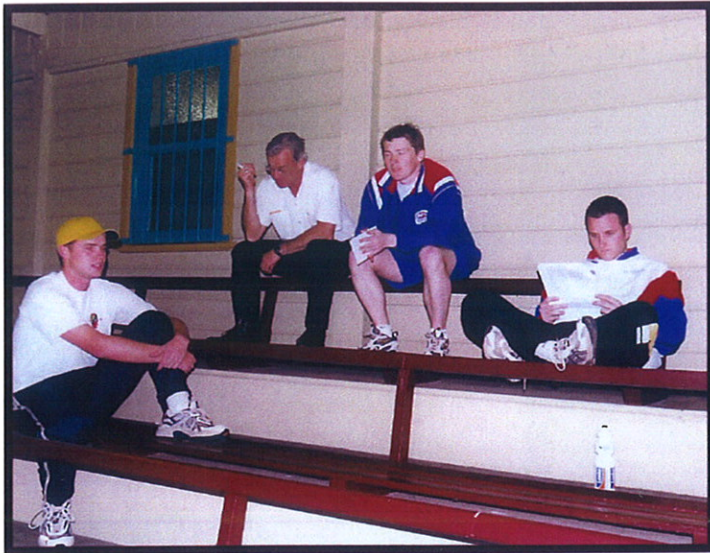

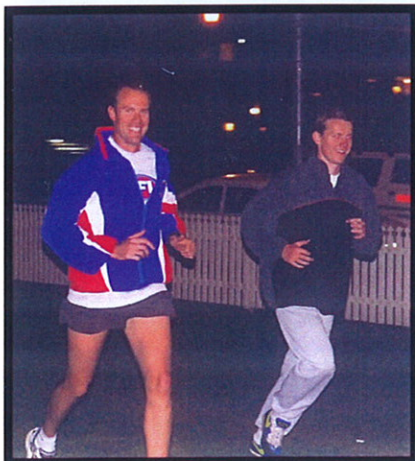
