





## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is my pleasure to provide you with my first report as President of the NSWAFUA.

There is no doubt that 2004 was a challenging year for your Association. A number of changes took place during the season including the abolishment of the Villi's cup pre-season competition, new uniforms and of course increased focus on fitness training in both the preseason and the season proper.

It was also the second year of the CBA, which had been working well and helped ensure that umpires salaries increased at a time when the AFL was facing significant funding shortfalls.

A new board was elected at the start of the season with Graham Glassford as President, who worked hard in the early part of the season to ensure the Association got off to a good start. However due to personal reasons he had to resign and I took over. It was a difficult time for the Association, with fewer people being actively involved in training, Association meetings and social functions.

On the social front, the Hall of Fame night, was again a success with over 100 people turning up to enjoy an evening of high quality food and service and entertaining guests. Sunday night pub gatherings at Forrester's started during the finals and was warmly received by our members.

The appointment of David Howlett as Director of Umpiring promises to bring some significant change to umpiring in Sydney and some structural change. The Association has a good working relationship with David and we look forward in being heavily involved in the development of umpiring in 2005.



## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The 2004 Sydney AFL season was one where increased pressure was put on the NSWAFUA to survive with reduced umpiring numbers in general and membership being affected.

The successful negotiation with the Sydney AFL of a three year Collective Bargaining Agreement that covers the 2003, 2004 and 2005 seasons meant that fees and conditions are fixed. Included in umpiring conditions is the supply of one uniform set and massage services at training. To recruit umpires and members, the Association must use the benefits of the CBA as a selling point.

The NSWAFUA took the radical step of changing the traditional white uniform to orange. This move certainly made umpires on the field stand out and has begun a new era. David Yole with primarily responsible for the change and his foresight needs to be applauded.

Once again the Association benefited from the financial backing of the Westfield Group, who supported the 2004 Hall of Fame Night. Mark Ryan from Westfield has continually helped out the Association and a big debt of gratitude is owed to him.

Just where does the NSWAFUA go from here? Membership numbers must improve and umpires need to be prepared to support the group by joining the Board or by attending functions. The Board puts in an enormous amount of work behind the scenes and needs the encouragement of all umpires.

Thank you to Robert Read who stepped into the breach as President at short notice and worked diligently to make the 2004 Hall of Fame Night a success when problems appeared certain to make the event a financial disaster.

The challenge for the 2005 season for the Association is to build for the future and work towards a new CBA covering 2006 and beyond.

# TREASURER'S REPORT


The financial year of 2004 was one of consolidation and trying to maintain member benefits in a period of declining membership. Membership is the main source of income for the Association and therefore it is essential to have a strong membership base for the Association to deliver services.

This year also saw the introduction of the orange uniforms which was one of the Associations largest expense. This purchase was to supply umpires needs over and above the one set provided by the AFL under the current CBA. It must be recognized that the Association still holds close to \$8000 in stock which is potential sales for future seasons.

A smaller financial membership base placed a burden on the funding of major Association events. These functions rely on the participation of the members to ensure they are successful. Unfortunately the lower numbers has meant the Association did not make any money on the related events such as raffles and memorabilia auctions as in past years. This combined with the increased costs of holding these functions has meant that they ran at a loss in 2004.


Despite this the Association members retain profits greater than those experienced in the previous year. This is a true reflection of the current finances but should not be a guide to the year ahead. Looking forward the Association needs to grow its membership base and have those members support the Association functions and services such as the canteen after training.



Peter thanked Darrell Luck for his help behind bar.


#### TREASURER'S REPORT:

"(b) A candidate for Life Membership must have rendered outstanding service to the Association as an active member of not fewer than ten (10) years standing or as an active member of not fewer than five (5) years standing including not fewer than three (3) years on the Committee, AND be nominated and seconded for election in writing lodged with the Secretary no later than fourteen (14) days before the Annual General Meeting at which the nomination is to be considered."

The motion is to change eligibility to read -

"(b) A candidate for Life Membership must have rendered outstanding service to the NSWAFUA or any equivalent Umpiring State or National Association as an active member of not fewer than ten (10) years standing or as an active member of not fewer than five (5) years standing including not fewer than three (3) years on the Committee, AND be nominated and seconded for election in writing lodged with the Secretary no later than fourteen (14) days before the Annual General Meeting at which the nomination is to be considered."

Discussion took place. Amendment approved.


