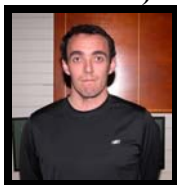

## **TREASURER'S REPORT**

The financial year of 2005 presented many challenges. The aim was to maintain the financial position of the members whilst battling against declining membership numbers. The change in uniform this year resulted in a financial write down of the previous inventory. The umpires' uniforms were supplied by the AFL this year so there was no added burden of paying for new uniforms.

The issue of sponsorship is always a difficult one for the Association. The Committee was unable to secure sponsorship this year which last year contributed \$5,500. A greater effort will be made next season to secure sponsorship which will relieve the entire financial burden from members.

The cost of our major social events continues to grow. The Presentation Night outweighs the entire receipts from membership when one accounts for the extra costs of video presentations. The issue of membership fees and its entitlements will be an issue for the incoming committee to consider.

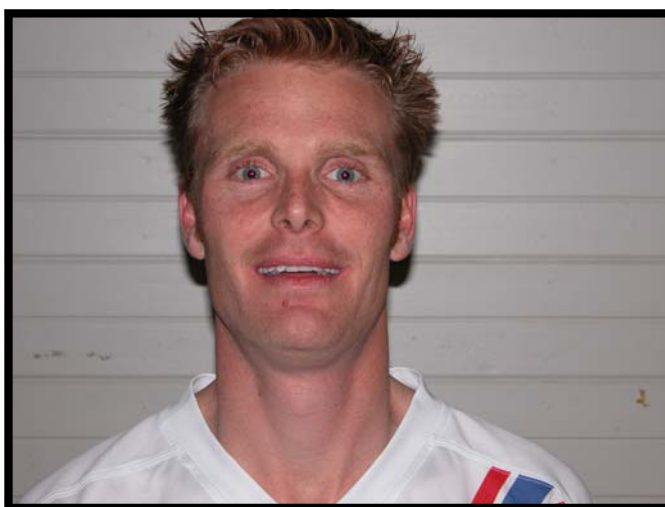
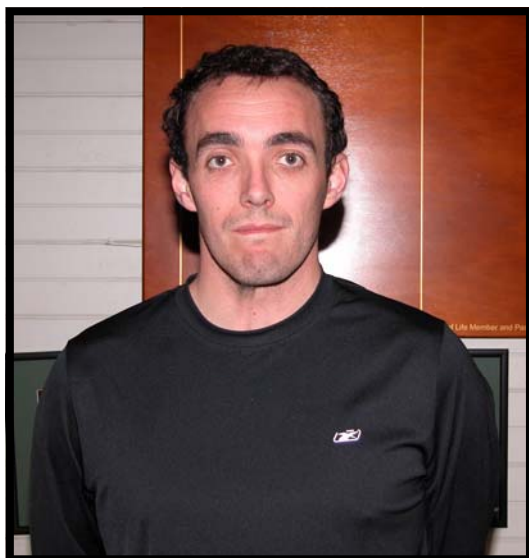

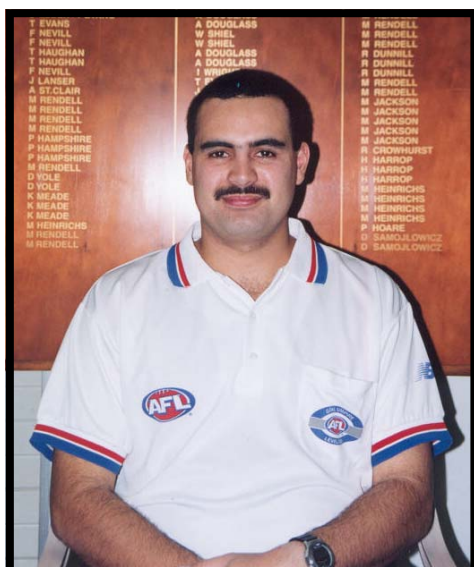
